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CONDITIONS OF PARADE ENTRIES

These conditions are to ensure a safe & enjoyable event for everyone

- The Parade follows the route – Church Road, Main Street, Maynooth Road.
- Fee for Commercial Entries €50, to be paid by cheque made payable to: Celbridge Community Council. * There will be no charge for applications by organisations which are not run for profit e.g. schools, charities and some community groups. Charge is €25 for other groups.
- Groups who do not complete & sign the formal application form cannot be allowed to participate Entries / Floats must assemble at the starting line (Church Road) at 3pm – the Parade commences at 4pm **sharp**
- All accepted entries will be provided with an entry number. This number will be communicated by text to the contact mobile number provided on this application, one week before the Parade.
- There will be a traffic cone with your entry number on it – please ensure all members of your group are aware of this number and go to it to assemble on arrival.
- An inspection of all entries / floats will take place before the parade commences.
- Groups can perform while moving through the streets. The duration for a static performance in front of the Viewing Stand (Main Street) is strictly 3 minutes maximum.
- No sweets / beverages should be given out to the crowd for health and safety reasons.
- For safety reasons, participants may not stand on moving trailers without correct handrails and restraint systems.
- There must be a driver at the wheel of any vehicle at all times.
- All float entrants must provide written confirmation of Public Liability insurance and any motor vehicle must have valid motor insurance.
- Generators must be diesel – where generators / motors are used, you must carry fit for purpose extinguishers e.g. foam / CO2 and they must be in date.
- The organizing committee will not be held responsible for any accident or incident before, during or after the Parade events.
- The organising committee retain the right to refuse entry to the Parade.
