What we do

St. Patrick's Day Parade

Over the past number of years we have attracted acts from the local community and beyond, with marching bands from the USA joining the Celbridge parade following their incredible performances in Dublin City.

With thousands attending the event each year, we are committed to nurturing this growth, ensuring that the parade

continues to thrive and evolve. We hope to welcome even more participants and spectators to join in the festivities for years to come.

Planning, Transport and Development

Our planning and development sub-committee monitors planning and development proposals that have the potential to impact Celbridge. We analyse any impacts before making submissions on public consultations or planning applications. We have wide representation from many areas of the town and our submissions aim to consider and represent the interests of the whole of the town.

We aim to:

- Carry out detailed research on housing, transport & infrastructure developments in Celbridge
- Make submissions to local and national authorities
- Contribute to local amenity projects
- Contribute to Kildare County Council development plans for Celbridge
